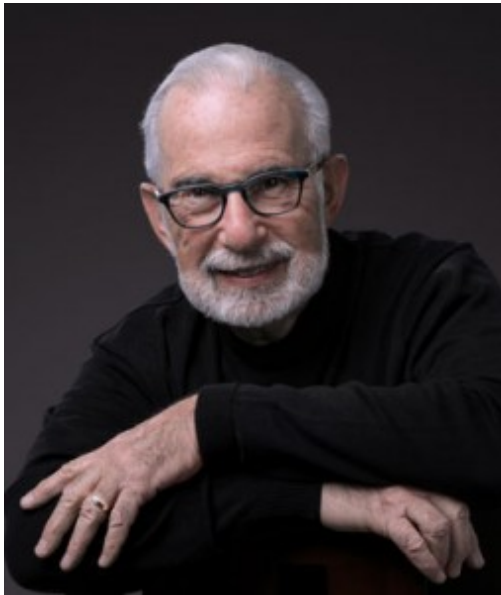


About Richard C. Senelick, M.D.

Dr. Senelick is also the author of the only Spanish language neurorehabilitation books available, including *La Vida Despues De Una Lesion Cerebral* (Paperback, HealthSouth Press, 2003), *La Vida Despues De Un Accidente Cerebrovascular* (Paperback, HealthSouth Press, 2003) and *La Lesión De La Médula Espinal* (Paperback, HealthSouth Press, 2003). He has also produced numerous educational videos.

After receiving his undergraduate degree and medical school training at the University of Illinois, he did his residency in neurology at the University of Utah. He also served as a Staff Neurologist for the United States Air Force at Lackland Air Force Base's Wilford Hall Medical Center from 1974-1976.

The author of over 100 articles ranging in scientific subjects, Dr. Senelick is affiliated with many academic organizations, including the American Academy of Neurology, American Society of Neurorehabilitation, Texas Medical Association, National Brain Injury Association, National Spinal Cord Injury Association and American Spinal Cord Injury Association.
